



## Use of Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on a computer's hard drive. The cookie file helps the site analyze web traffic, or indicates when there is a repeat visitor. In effect, cookies allow web applications to respond to the individual visitor. The website can tailor its operations to the the visitor's needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about their preferences.

Traffic log cookies identify which pages are being used. This helps analyze data about web page traffic, improving the website. This information is only used for statistical analysis purposes.

A cookie in no way gives access to the visitor's computer or any information about them, other than the data they choose to directly share!

Overall, cookies help provide visitors with a better website, by both improving functionality, and by discovering which pages visitors find useful.
