



Did you install Microsoft Silverlight on you Macintosh, no longer visit websites which need it, and are tired of the pop-ups that ask to update it? Here is how to painlessly remove Microsoft Silverlight from Mac OS X.

Uninstall Microsoft Silverlight from Mac OS X

1. Use the Finder to open /Library/Internet Plug-Ins
2. Delete Silverlight.plugin
3. Delete WPFplugin.plugin (if it exists).

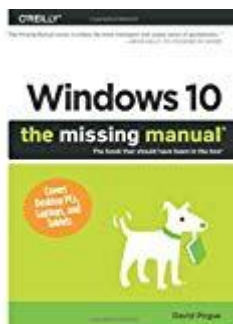
Notes

- The file(s) to be removed are in the Mac OS X “system Library” not your “user Library”. Use the exact path above.
- You be prompted to type in your administrative password when you modify library files. In this case, you are deleting files.
